What you told us



EasyRead version



Every 3 months we ask the people we support what they think about our service.



Each time we ask about different things.



We also set up a group to talk about what people have said and what changes we need to make. This is called the My Voice Working Group



This time we asked about sexuality and relationships.



11 people responded to the survey.

What people told us



Question 1 asked if people were able to keep their private lives as private as they wanted it to be.



Everyone said Yes.



Question 2 asked if people got support to have privacy or a personal place to go if wanted.



Everyone said Yes.



Question 3 asked if people got the support and information they needed about having a boyfriend or girlfriend when they asked.



Only 5 out of 11 said Yes.



Question 4 asked if people wanted more information on sexuality.



Only 1 person said Yes.



Question 5 asked if people were able to talk to staff about any difficulties with girlfriends or boyfriends.



6 people said no.



Question 6 asked if people needed any help or information about safe sex.



Only 1 person said yes.

What we do well



People were able to keep their lives private when they wanted to.

What we can do better



It was a worry that not many people answered these questions. This means we cannot be sure how many people the answers are true for.



One problem was how some managers dealt with people's sexuality and relationships.



Some people would like more information and support as well as having someone to talk to.



Sometimes the information and support we gave did not help people's relationships.



So, we will look at training staff on the best ways to give the support people want.



And work with other organisations to get better information for when people want it.
